# Achievements so far: Armenia



## NATIONAL ROAD SAFETY COUNCIL NGO, ARMENIA



Successfully advocated for 30km/h school zones to be included in the Draft National Road Safety Strategy.



Pilot 30km/h zones introduced at 3 schools in Yerevan.

# Achievements so far: Georgia



## PARTNERSHIP FOR ROAD SAFETY, GEORGIA



Successfully advocated for 30km/h speed limits around schools in Rustavi, Tbilisi, and Zugdidi.

In Zugdidi, the city made it a policy priority and implemented 30km/h limits at all 57 schools in the city.



In Tbilisi new standards including 30km/h limits were adopted and have been implemented at 24 schools.



In Rustavi, speed limits have been reduced at 15 schools.
